Next week I will be with you again. I am very grateful for your generosity and patience in allowing me this time to rest and be with my family. You have been in my prayers every day. I have missed you greatly and am looking forward to seeing you!



On the weekend of February 10 and 11 (next weekend), we will have **Name Tag Sunday** at all of our churches. The readings for this week tell us about how God heals the broken hearted and how he reaches out to all. We all go through difficult times and experience suffering in many different ways. God feels our pain and is always trying to find ways to come to us with comfort and healing. In most cases, God reaches out to us through those around us — our friends, our family, our community. We hope that our parish communities will always be those places, those families where all can feel welcomed, embraced, accepted, comforted and healed. Through our hospitality, openness and service to others, we continue Christ's Mission in this world and fulfill the wishes of God's heart that longs to heal broken humanity. I invite all to make an effort and wear a name tag.

This weekend, we have Fr. Dennis Cleary, MM, visiting us and preaching about the **Maryknoll Missions**, again a way in which God's desire to reach out to all peoples with healing and comfort is fulfilled. I ask that you welcome him in the wonderful way you always do, in the same way you have made me feel at home from day one, and if you can support the Maryknoll efforts to bring the joy of the Gospel to so many countries, please do so.



This weekend also, we celebrate St. Blaise and will have the blessing of throats at all of our Masses. With this blessing, the Church reaches out to all who are sick, and all are invited to receive the blessing, even if not sick, to prevent illness. This time of year, we are especially prone to suffer colds, the flu, etc. and this blessing is quite timely. As we go through this flu season, we will continue to do our best as always to keep our sacred vessels, holy water fountains, and churches clean and disinfected. Each one is free to exercise prudence in attending church when possibly ill and in the manner of sharing the sign of peace and receiving Holy Communion. Remember that in receiving only the host or only the cup, we receive both the Body and Blood of Christ just the same.
