### Sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick

This Sacrament is available for individuals upon request, and communal celebrations are periodically scheduled.

### Ministry to the Sick

Please call a parish office concerning the needs of the sick, hospitalized or shut-ins. Those unable to attend Mass may have Communion brought to them.

**A NOTE FROM  
DEACON GEORGE...**

As I stated in the past, my family immigrated to the United States after World War II. My parents spoke Polish and English, but also knew some German, Russian, and Italian. So, in my childhood life, I was surrounded by different languages. In elementary school, the nuns made sure that we understood Latin, and in high school and college, I studied French and Russian.

Language is how we express ourselves. It can be unifying, but it can also be divisive because we need to be able to communicate with each other, and we need to understand each other. On Pentecost Sunday, that barrier between the different tribes of humans fell away as the Apostles spoke in a language that everyone understood.

The gift of tongues is a gift of the Holy Spirit, and not all of us are blessed with such a gift, but there are other gifts of the Holy Spirit: wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety, and fear of the Lord. These gifts are all available to us, and they are all tied to the ultimate gift of God, which is the gift of love. Love is language that we all understand, no matter what we speak. It is through love that the message of the Gospel can reach the ears and the hearts of people.

This Pentecost, we celebrate the Holy Spirit descending on the Apostles and Mary. Also, this year, Pope Francis declared that the Monday after Pentecost would be a new feast day in honor of "Mary, Mother of the Church." Mary is an example to all of us of those gifts of love and sacrifice that help spread the Gospel to all corners of the world. So, let us dedicate ourselves to spreading the Gospel by our actions and words by showing love to one another, and being more charitable, more forgiving, and more kind.

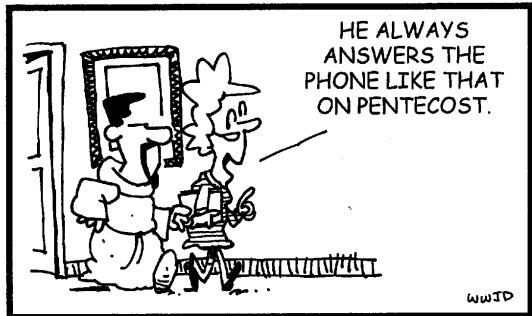
